Programs must be free and open to all members of the public. The library is unable to offer monetary compensation to program partners.

If your program is selected, the Library coordinates the program in partnership with you, and the Library provides our venue, a poster, online marketing, and event liability insurance. We hope the program partner will promote in additional ways. The library cannot guarantee an audience of any particular size.
